Learn how to make Edo Tsumami Kanzashi from the only authentic Edo Tsumami Kanzashi artisan in the U.S.! Kanzashi is an ornamental hairpin and its history goes back as far as 3000 years. The Edo Tsumami Kanzashi style was formed during the Edo period and it was mainly worn by maidens for celebrations (see above picture-right). The Edo Tsumami Kanzashi is a National Designated Traditional Handicraft but the art is disappearing as kimono-wearing population decreased.

In this workshop, you will make four Plum blossom Edo Tsumami Kanzashi Bobby Pins (see above picture-left) and also learn about history/materials/artisanship of the Kanzashi. The price includes all materials (color of the kanzashi can be chosen from a selection).

Students who complete this class on the 18^{th} can proceed to level 2 offered in October to learn new technique/design. In order to proceed, students must complete each level to get sufficient practice. Students may repeat the same level if they feel that they are not ready to proceed. New students are always welcome to Level 1 workshop.
